
WARREN ISENSEE

NEW YORK – MILES MCENERY GALLERY is pleased to announce its representation of Warren Isensee.

Warren Isensee's Geometric Abstractionist paintings celebrate a precision of line and juxtaposition of color. Isensee paints every line freehand, inserting his personal touch into hardedge paintings. At first glance, the paintings lack any sign of his hand, but with a closer look, imperfect edges reveal themselves and breathe life into his compositions.

On his interest in color, Isensee remarks, "I concentrate on the relationship the colors have to each other one at a time, with each carefully mixed to activate those next to it. It can take hours to mix the particular yellow I need to light up the adjacent orange. I use black as a form of punctuation to emphasize and define the luminosity of color, while white is used both as positive and negative space. A goal is for the intensity of the color relationships to render them equal to the forms they inhabit."



WARREN ISENSEE (b. 1956 in Asheville, NC) studied architecture at the University of Oklahoma, before

majoring in painting and graphic design. He received the Joan Mitchell Foundation Grant in 1999. He was included in the 2007 American Academy of Arts and Letters Invitational Exhibition of Visual Arts, receiving a Purchase Award.
